

Course Description – Criminal Procedure Law

Course Title: Criminal Procedure Law

Course Credits: 11

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: This course focused on criminal procedure law, and includes all phases of criminal investigation, prosecution, and trial. The students will have an opportunity to understand the written law of criminal procedure, discuss domestic and international case-law, and solve hypotheticals. The course will be delivered through the classical method of classroom lectures and seminars, but interactive methods will be integrated in them to make this course more accessible, to the students.

Course Goals: Master the fundamentals of criminal procedure by learning the relevant legal provisions and judicial doctrines, and applying the rules to hypothetical cases.

Course Requirements: Failure to attend at least 25% of seminars means the students cannot enter the final exam. If absent in more than 50%, the exam must be taken in the consecutive year; otherwise, the exam might be taken in the fall semester.

The student is required to take active participation in seminars and present a paper based on specific guidance.

Grading: The final grade will be determined based on a maximum score of 100 points. These will be collected in the following way:

- Maximum 20 points for a paper;
- Maximum 20 points for contributions to seminars;
- Maximum 60 points for a final written exam.

Course Schedule: The course includes 105 hours of lectures and 30 hours of seminars. Lectures will be delivered weekly. The schedule of activities is subject to change.
