Course Title: Civilization of France

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: French

Course Description: This course aims to provide students with the basic knowledge on various aspects of French civilization: geo-political, economic, cultural aspects as well as other aspects of daily life.

It also aims to introduce students to a real francophone spirit and culture that often differs from the official one.

Students are offered the opportunity to deepen and enrich their knowledge of French-speaking countries, such as the history, geography, politics, economy, literature and culture of these countries.

Course Goals: The student must first of all be able to distinguish concretely what the concept of civilization is in his first language so that he can deepen his knowledge of the francophone world. In this syllabus, he will be able to deepen his knowledge in the field of the civilization of France but also of the French-speaking countries, seeing as well the differences that the language has in the different countries where he travels and the influence that culture has on him. As it specifically concerns the civilization of France, students will focus on concepts such as: language, evolution, history, wars, geography, reliefs, economy, population, traditions and customs, changes, daily life, professional life, money, salary and work, laws and powers etc.
