Course title: Group and team dynamics

Course credits: 7

Language of instruction: Albanian

Course Description: The course "Group and team dynamics" presents a presentation of the developments of working groups and organizations, the progress of work in it, the types of different working groups. The course occupies an important place in the further profiling of students at the level of Master of Science in organizational psychology.

The objectives of the course are: to develop and train in the treatment of cases of a psychological nature in the workplace, institution and organization; to develop advanced knowledge on the development of group work and its features, offer different working group models, scientifically prepare students for the nature of complexity and correlation, factors that affect the dynamics of the group, to be trained with different types of groups and the possibilities of their action, to be practically trained with the intervention and management of group interaction situations.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated based on the following:

- Course assignment - 20 points (maximum).
- Mid-term exam -20 points (maximum).
- Final written exam - 60 points (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (96-100 points); Grade 9 (86-95 points); Grade 8 (76-85 points); Grade 7 (66-75 points); Grade 6 (56-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: The course "Group and team dynamics" has a semester extension (15 weeks, with weekly academic workload 2/1 (2 hours lectures, one hour seminar). Lectures and seminars attendance is mandatory not less than 75% of hours.
