Course Title: Advanced models and skills for working with families

Course Credits: 6

Language of Instruction: Albanian, English.

Course Description: "Advanced models and skills for working with families" subject takes place in the study program "Professional Master in Social Services". Students gain knowledge related to the analysis of intervention models for various family problems. The family assessment is applied according to the strengths perspective of the family, referring to a systemic framework, focusing on the therapeutic interventions that the professional performs with the families.

Course Goals: It is intended to achieve the ability of students regarding the understanding of the dynamics of family development, the identification and description of intervention techniques, also relying on the models and techniques of family therapy with a systemic focus as well as enabling students to handle and evaluate various family problems.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated based on the following:

- Active participation in the seminars hours - 10 points (maximum).
- Intermediate exam -10 points (maximum).
- Course assignment - 20 points (maximum).
- Final written exam - 60 points (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (96-100 points); Grade 9 (86-95 points); Grade 8 (76-85 points); Grade 7 (66-75 points); Grade 6 (56-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: This course takes place in the second semester, with weekly academic workload 2/1 (two hours lectures, one hour seminar). Lectures attendance is not mandatory. Seminars attendance is mandatory not less than 75% of hours.
