Course Title: Dialectology

Course Credits: 6 ECTS

Language of Instruction: Albanian

Course Description: Dialectology aims to train a student in terms of knowing the dialects of the albanian language, sub-dialects or speech groups.

Gives basic linguistic knowledge of dialects, dialect division, the special characteristics of their speech, making a difference with the standard language.

Course Goals: With the acquired knowledge, they must distinguish the characteristics of each dialect in the system of consonant and vowel phonemes, recognition of dialect boundaries, reading a dialect text and its definition, as well as know how to make a dialectological analysis, based on the phonetic, morphological, lexical and syntactic system. The student must know well the relevant dialect of each province.

Course Requirements: Activation in seminar sessions and attendance . Coursework. Exam

Grading: Attendance: Activation in seminar sessions and attendance - 10 points

Continuous control: Test during the semester: 30 points

Exam: 60 points

Course Schedule: The student must attend 75% of lectures and seminars. In another case, any absence must be justifiable. He should be active in the seminars, either with the preparation of a topic, or in the development of exercises. This helps the student earn points during the semester.
