Course Title: The art of writing

Course Credits: 8

Language of Instruction: French

Course Description:

This course aims :

- To teach students the main rules and techniques of writing in French, starting from the most common forms such as drafting an invitation, postcard, announcement, publicity, various letters, personal diary, programs or tourist guides, CV, to longer forms such as drafting a summary, comment, synthesis, essay, necessary during their experience of university studies.
- To sensitize them with the linguistic, technical and cultural practices of these forms of writing
- To exercise in the application of spelling rules.

Course Goals:

At the end of this course, students will have expanded their knowledge of the French language, in particular the competence of written expression. They will be able to analyze and draft different forms of creative writing respecting language structures and in accordance with French culture. Reviewing and correcting documents will help develop a sense of reflection and critical thinking.

The rubric: "Practice in academic writing" will enable them to create a Portfolio with necessary documents during their university education.
