Course Title: French Morphosyntax

Course Credits: 12

Language of Instruction: French

Course Description:

The content of this course (lecture and seminar classes) concerns the basic concepts of French grammar, grammatical and logical analysis (identification of grammatical and syntactic categories, determination of syntactic functions, typology of sentences, etc), explanation of the main grammatical difficulties (adaptation of the past participle, place of the adjective, choice of the relative pronoun, characteristics of verbs, etc) and the principles of orthography.

Course Goals:

The first part refers to morphology, which aims to make students aware of this basic subject by dealing with the basic knowledge for the acquisition and use of different parts of speech, the function of words, further deepening of the knowledge acquired on seen by students for different grammatical phenomena.

The syntax part has as its main objective the deepening of knowledge in the internal structure of the simple sentence and the compound sentence, based on the various contemporary theories that deal with its construction and composition.

Course Requirements:

- Attendance (the course has to be attended in 75%% for the lecture and seminar classes),
- Active Participation,
- Mid-term exams,
- Final exam.

Grading:

A final course grade will be the sum total of the points allocated to each completed requirement.

30 % is the active participation during the semester and 70 % the final exam.

Course Schedule:

The course is scheduled in two semesters, 2 fifty-minute lecture classes and 2 fifty-minute seminar classes per week.
