Course Title: Written Language Skills I

Course Credits: 14

Language of Instruction: Italian

Course Description: The course consist in the text and its requirements: cohesion and coherence, summary, paraphrase, ideation, drafting and revision. Written language practice is considered a practical subject which gives the student the opportunity to exercise the knowledge and skills acquired in the Italian language and to reflect on it, especially in the competence of writing. The course aims to train students in the best possible use of the written language by practicing with various typologies of epistolary, orthographic, argumentative, publicity texts, etc. The student understands what are the appropriate techniques and strategies for their realization.

Course Goals: The course aims to enable the student to different linguistic requests or situations, to interact with different texts, to have very good grammatical knowledge of language level B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages He has the ability to create his own style and ideas, to organize them in the right way. Able to create a text with arguments from the simplest to the most difficult.

Course Requirements: Attendance and engagement during the course, periodical controls and a written topic is foreseen during it. Written exam, based on article 25/5 of "Regulation of studies, first full-time cycle".

Grading: 5,2 ects continuous assessment, 8,8 ects the final exam.

Course Schedule: A total of 180 hours of practical work and 170 hours of individual student work.
