Course Title: Didactics of phonetics and lexicology

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: French

Course Description:

During the theoretical courses we deal with the importance of pronunciation and vocabulary in learning a foreign language, the objectives of teaching phonetics and vocabulary, the contribution of phonetic issues to communication, the teaching of phonetics and vocabulary through the different teaching methods, the place of phonetics and vocabulary in FFL textbooks.

The seminar courses concern activities and tools for teaching / learning phonetics and vocabulary, correcting pronunciation errors, strategies to develop lexical skills and educational advices for a successful course.

Course Goals:

The course aims to help students, future teachers, to acquire different strategies for teaching the French phonetics and lexicology. The various activities and exercises should aim to develop in the student the ability and desire to use the knowledge in concrete communicative situations.

Course Requirements:

- Attendance (the course has to be attended in 60% for the lecture classes and 75% for the seminar classes),
- Active participation,
- Mid-term exams,
- Final exam.

Grading:

A final course grade will be the sum total of the points allocated to each completed requirement.

30 % is the active participation during the semester and 70 % the final exam.

Course Schedule:

The course is scheduled in one semester, 2 fifty-minute lecture classes and 2 fifty-minute seminar classes per week.
