

Sample Course Description

Study program: Business - Administration

Course Title: Business law

Course Credits: 5

Language of Instruction: Albanian (*as well in English*)

Course Description: The purpose of this course is to address some of the most important issues of business law. During the course, the student will get in the basic institutes of private law as well as the legal forms of introducing commercial enterprises to the market. Types of commercial companies, newest typologies of contracting forms are the basic issues with which the students will be introduced during this cycle of lectures. At the end, the student will receive the necessary knowledge regarding the legal ways of doing business. There will also be basic knowledge of the legal way of contractual agreements, ownership rights, various legal commercial and business relationships.

Course Goals: The key goals are on definitions and classification of rights; legal-civil relationship, legal entities, legal entities and commercial companies; special institutes of civil law, representation and legal actions; ownership and liability relations; contracts and negotiation method.

Course Requirements: Attendance 75%; Evaluation during the course is based on oral control of the knowledge as well on case law presented during the course.

Grading: 20% of the overall evaluation (100%) will be given on oral seminar control. These evaluations will added to the final exam, which will take place through the written form and will take 80% of the overall evaluation.
