Course Title: English History and Culture

Course Credits: 8 ECTS

Language of Instruction: English

Course Description: In this course we will trace the development of Great Britain from prehistoric times to the present day. It looks at British history not merely in terms of kings, queens, battles, but also emphasises economic, social, intellectual forces and how these affected the everyday lives of people from different sections of society. It is a history of Britain, not just of England. It looks at major developments within Scotland, Wales, Ireland as well as their relations with England.

Course Goals: enhance cultural awareness and competence; study the bulk of the heritage and history of England, Wales, Scotland, Province of Northern Ireland, their geography, political, social systems, cultural settings, and everyday life in general; engage with, reflect upon, and respond to a range of key historical issues, such as significant events, data of the given period, power as well as influence of specific political leaders, etc.
