PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS & MAIN ACTIVITIES (2023–2026)

Building Strong Foundations

The project successfully established a **robust management and quality framework**, ensuring smooth coordination among partners, transparent reporting, and continuous quality monitoring throughout all project phases. Regular consortium meetings and external monitoring strengthened collaboration and accountability.

Research & Needs Analysis

A comprehensive **research and needs analysis** was conducted to map the state of *Internationalization at Home (IaH)* across EU and Western Balkan universities. These insights formed the evidence base for all subsequent developments, ensuring that project solutions were **context-specific, inclusive, and sustainable**.

Developing Systems & Support for IaH

The project designed and implemented **institutional strategies, digital support systems, and operational protocols** to support international students and staff without physical mobility. Pilot services were tested and refined, creating **practical, scalable IaH models** at partner institutions.

Internationalization of the Curriculum





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A major achievement was the **integration of international and intercultural dimensions into teaching and learning.**

Key activities included:

- Training academic staff in **Internationalization of the Curriculum (IoC)**
- Introducing **COIL, CLIL, EMI, and virtual teaching models**
- Developing and piloting **international virtual courses**
- Strengthening digital infrastructure through **international virtual classrooms**

These actions brought global perspectives directly into the home curriculum.

Impact, Visibility & Dissemination

Project results were widely shared through **info days, workshops, symposia, conferences, and digital platforms**. Tailored dissemination tools increased visibility among students, academic staff, policymakers, and international stakeholders. Sustainability strategies ensure that project outcomes will **continue beyond the project lifetime**.

By embedding internationalization into everyday academic practice, the project has:


- Expanded **inclusive international learning opportunities**
